CHRISTIAN WORLD OUTREACH

Banquet Project #607

Christian World Outreach (CWO) began their ministry in Haiti in the late 1970s to help people living in extreme poverty. Twenty years later they expanded their programs to include work on the continent of Africa. They currently work in Burkina Faso, Zimbabwe, and Zambia.

CWO has been in Zambia since 2002 and directs three key community programs: Evangelistic Outreach & Discipleship; HIV/AIDS Prevention & Education; and Learning Libraries. Like most ministries in the developing world, a vehicle is a key part of day-to-day operations and in serving those whom the ministry connects with. The CWO staff travels many miles on rugged roads to minister to people, many of whom are sick or have been badly burned and unable to walk. Traveling to these remote locations requires a reliable vehicle. A **Toyota Hilux** is one of the most sought after vehicles in Zambia because it is reliable, tough, and easy to maintain. It also allows the staff to carry heavy items such as building materials and supplies for outreach events.

COMPLETED PROJECT #597: Middle East

The reports are staggering: **70 million people** have been directly affected by the conflicts raging in Syria, Iraq, Yemen, and Libya. As refugees pour out of these and other countries, the need to restore peace to the region has become a matter of urgency.

You may watch these news reports and wonder, “What can I do to bring encouragement to these people?” **Our donors have responded** by helping us complete Project #597 for the ministry of **SAT-7**.

Even in these tense situations, SAT-7 continues to bring a message of hope, peace, and truth. Because so many homes in this region have satellite TV, SAT-7 is uniquely and strategically able to share the Good News of love and forgiveness. The new **Skype video equipment** they received through our ministry is helping



viewers connect with them in a more personal way. Live programs give viewers an opportunity to

participate through telephone call-ins, enabling people scattered throughout the region to share their views about what is happening to them.

This equipment also helps each SAT-7 studio connect with other studios around the region. Program makers can incorporate multi-site live shows or include subject-matter experts from other areas.

For many isolated and persecuted believers, these opportunities to connect are incredibly meaningful, encouraging, and vital to their faith. **Thank you for giving!**



Mobile Education Team at Work in Lebanon

COMPLETED PROJECT #589: Syria/Lebanon

Since the conflict in Syria began, the number of Syrian refugees fleeing to Lebanon has exceeded two million. It is estimated that more than half of these are **under the age of 18**. Some arrive with their families, others are orphaned, but they all arrive tired, hungry, and shell shocked. Many are in need of immediate medical care and most of the children have gone without schooling for months or even years.

Heart for Lebanon (H4L) has developed a non-formal, classroom education program in three locations: the Bekaa Valley, Beirut, and South. However, because of the overwhelming number of children, they cannot minister to all of them. H4L has, therefore, created a **Mobile Education Team** which visits refugee community camps on a regular basis, sharing the love of Christ and offering them an education.



This project was completed in May and provided the Mobile Team with **portable sound-system equipment**, enabling them to use a variety of ways to capture children’s attention as they learn through programs such as:

- ❖ Christian videos and Bible story puppet shows
- ❖ Educational programs in math, Arabic, and English
- ❖ Movie nights, birthday parties, and other community events for refugee families
- ❖ Interactive workshops about health, hygiene, and dental care

CHRISTIAN WORLD OUTREACH

In Zambia, this help consists of evangelism and outreach work, HIV/AIDS education, and oversight of a learning library. The CWO staff is in need of a reliable vehicle for the rough terrain and many miles they travel in their work. The **2006 Toyota Hilux** is a reliable vehicle, both durable and easy to maintain.

608 -Middle East

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATING MINISTRIES

COST: \$ 10,000

ICM equips and disciples indigenous congregations to reach their communities for Christ. They now have a unique opportunity to reach Syrian refugees with the Gospel through their *Mini Bible College* (MBC) materials. The discreet, portable design of the audio unit allows people to study the curriculum in their own homes or in small groups. This project will provide 200 units of the **MBC audio player** to a specific country in the Middle East for only \$50 per unit.

609 -Sierra Leone

CLC MINISTRIES, INT'L

COST: \$ 8,150

CLC Ministries endeavors to meet the demand for Christian literature in Sierra Leone. It is often difficult and expensive to ship books overseas; therefore, CLC is planning to provide their national director with a **Publish4All Print-on-Demand** (POD) system. This will enable them to produce biblical materials anywhere and to share these resources with other Christian ministries. Equipment Needs: computer, cutter, binder, three printers, two wide-format printers, and a power package.

610 -North Africa

STREAMS OF LIVING WATER

COST: \$ 1,480

Streams of Living Water works through the ministry *Pioneers* to provide support and administration for several training schools in North Africa. These are the first missionary schools in the region whose goal is to equip indigenous pastors to evangelize and disciple unreached people groups in North Africa and the Middle East. One of the schools is in need of **two desktop computers, one laptop, and one printer**.

CEF MINISTRIES

COST: \$ 10,500

The county of Dambovita, Romania, has over 260 villages with no evangelical witness. CEF workers are in need of a car to take them into remote locations to reach more children with the Gospel. It will also help in transporting teaching materials and the many volunteers needed to run various after-school clubs. They are asking for funds to purchase a **used VW Caddy**.

UIM INTERNATIONAL - AVIATION

COST: \$ 9,826

UIM assists world evangelism by providing aviation services to missionaries, Native pastors, and other Christian organizations. They operate in Northern Mexico and the Southwestern U.S. to transport supplies, Bible translators, missionaries, ministry leaders, and people who need medical treatment. UIM is in need of **safety and maintenance equipment** which will be used to maintain the aircraft and facilities and to enhance proficiency and safety.


