When a child comes into a Chariots For Hope children's home in **Kenya**, they become **part of a family**. Each child is given shelter, nutritious food, clothing, and medical care; but the staff go above and beyond meeting their physical needs by also providing for their social, emotional, and spiritual wellbeing.



There are currently **six children's homes** and **two baby homes** supported by Chariots For Hope. Romanian Team Receives Needed Vehicle

UPDATE ON PROJECT #611: CEF Ministries

Equipment: Used Volkswagen Caddy

EverychildinRomania is a project of CEF Ministries whose goal is to promote awareness of specific ministry needs within the country of Romania. Last fall, they contacted us about the need for a vehicle in the county of **Dambovita** which has less than 2% of evangelical Christians. This county has more than 260 villages with no evangelical witness, therefore, many children have never heard that there is a creator God who loves them and has a purpose for their lives.

Since receiving the new vehicle this past spring, the CEF Romanian team has been able to reach children living in remote regions of Dambovita and are able to more easily

transport volunteers and teaching materials to different areas when needed. Already over **1,000 children** hear the Gospel on a regular basis in conjunction with CEF Camps and 5-Day Clubs that took place this summer where even more children heard the Good News of Jesus!

UPDATE ON PROJECT #612: UIM - Aviation

Equipment: Safety & Maintenance Equipment

UIM assists world evangelism by providing aviation services to missionaries, native pastors, and organizations seeking to reach remote people groups in Mexico with the Gospel.

Funds from this project were used to purchase a variety of **safety and maintenance tools** to enhance the hangar facilities and ensure proper maintenance and safety of the airplanes.




Paul Timblin

He works closely with over 800 children and 100 staff members, visiting each home numerous times a year and keeping in constant communication with them. #626 HEART FOR LEBANON

Heart For Lebanon addresses the problem of poverty among Syrian and Iraqi refugees while also ministering to the Bedouins and Gypsies in Lebanon. They have developed a non-formal, mobile education program for the overwhelming number of children called H.O.P.E (Helping Overcome Poverty through Education) with their main operations being in Beirut, the Bekaa Valley, and Southern Lebanon. *Exact project requirements to be determined at a later date.

#623 CEF MINISTRIES

In 2016, CEF reached over 26,900 children with the Gospel. They realize that they are still losing a whole generation of 5-13 year olds who have never heard of Jesus, so this year their goal is to reach 40,000 children—evangelizing them, discipling them, and establishing them in local churches. To reach this goal, they need to equip their Haitian staff with **six new computers** to help them plan, promote, and coordinate this great undertaking. www.haitione.org

Peace Children's Home in Kallur, India currently houses 87 boys and girls. They have an urgent need for a **water filtration/purification system** (\$1,000) which is mandated by the government. Recently their two-year-old well failed to pass all the tests for low level contaminants such as fluoride and arsenic.

Another need is for **closed circuit cameras** (\$1,000) which the government has also mandated in all children's homes for security purposes and treatment of the children.
