### GETTING TO KNOW... THE AMERICA'S

- **BOLIVIA** has 37 official languages; the two most popular are Spanish and Quechua.
- License plates in **CANADA'S** Northwest Territories are shaped like polar bears. 
- **ECUADOR** was named for the equator which runs through the country. It is the only country in the world named after a geographical feature.

## Helping Families Stay on the Mission Field

### UPDATE ON PROJECT #602: SHARE Education Services

**Equipment:** Educational Equipment for Hungary



Families serving throughout Europe, Russia/Ukraine, Central Asia/Turkey, and the Middle East are actively involved in evangelism, church planting, discipleship, and teaching. One of the **key reasons** why families leave the mission field prematurely is due to problems with their children's education and cultural adjustment issues.

**SHARE Education Services** provides support to these families through conferences, testing, and consulting. Each year SHARE hears from parents who say that without having them as a resource, they would have returned home in frustration and despair.



With the purchase of **new equipment** through this project, SHARE is now able to add webinars (seminars that takes place on the Internet) to serve families who cannot get to conferences or who need support in between conference times. The **iPads** are being used at SHARE Family Education Conferences in Hungary to teach children and teens and are also helpful in doing workshop presentations. Using the **new laptops** gives SHARE the ability to do extensive testing for children and teens.

This new lightweight, portable equipment simplifies travel to remote locations to test children and consult with parents. Having these services is a tremendous help to missionary families serving overseas!

### UPDATE ON PROJECT #619: Pioneer Bible Translators

**Equipment:** Two Motorcycles for Guinea, West Africa



**Pioneer Bible Translators** supports the Yalunka church in **Guinea** where they envision planting a church in every village in their language group by the end of 2018. They have had steady success over the past 2.5 years largely due to the hard work of a local missionary.



In fact, this missionary has had **so much success** that follow-up teaching had grown beyond his own abilities. Thankfully several other church leaders stepped forward, willing to help with the evangelizing and teaching effort. After the completion of this project last year, the **new motorcycles were purchased** and are now in use by these faithful men (photos below).



This Yalunka evangelist, who organizes Scripture reading groups among the Susu, received a new motorbike.



Paul, an evangelist working among the Yalunka in Guinea and Sierra Leone, also received a new motorbike for his ministry.

## #633 PRIORITY ONE INDIA

Priority One India has ministries spread over eleven Indian states and in the country of Nepal. Often, leaders from Karnataka State travel to area churches to conduct special meetings, conferences, pastors' schools, and youth and children's programs. Traveling by train or public transportation is time consuming and difficult. Having a vehicle would be a great help to the ministry and to the local churches. This project is for an SUV from Tata Motors.

## #634 BCM INTERNATIONAL

BCM Int'l. has planted over 1,000 churches in the country of India. They are now experiencing incredible ministry among young people on the island nation of Sri Lanka. In order to reach more people with the Gospel, BCM is in need of **20 bicycles** (\$120 each) for pastors in India and **4 motorbikes** (\$1,900 each) for pastors in Sri Lanka. This will increase their ability to visit congregations and plant new churches and also provide a safer, more efficient means of travel.
