UPDATE ON PROJECT #621: Chariots For Hope Equipment: Toyota Land Cruiser Prado

Last fall, MPF celebrated 50 years of ministry at its annual banquet. Donations were used to complete a car project for **Paul Mwaniki**, National Director of Chariots For Hope. Paul is the supervisor for each manager at the six children's homes and two baby homes located throughout southern Kenya.



The homes currently provide a safe haven for more than 800 children. To look after the needs of so many, almost one hundred staff members serve the homes in various capacities. For example, each home has a home manager (aka "dad" or "mom") who has overall responsibility for the children in their care. You will also find assistant managers, dorm moms and nursemaids,

cooks, groundskeepers, and security guards looking after the children's safety and well-being.

The following paragraph is part of a report from **Andelyn Robb**, U.S. Director with Chariots for Hope, who recently visited Paul in Kenya:

"I just returned from several weeks in Kenya and had the pleasure of spending a good deal of time with our National Director, Paul, riding around in the **new vehicle** your ministry gifted to us last fall. As we were navigating rough roads (and when I say rough, picture driving through a field complete with large rocks and gullies formed from excessive rain) to get our team members to our children's home, Paul mentioned several times what a blessing the new vehicle has been... A vehicle may sound simple, but know that your gift to our ministry has significant impacts on the work we do."
