When OneWay Africa learned that the Nakundugu Community in **Northern Ghana** was experiencing a water crisis (see photo below on right), they contacted MPF to see if we would take on a project to bring them clean water and solar-powered audio Bibles.

## # 656 CHRISTIAN MISSION FOR THE DEAF - NIGERIA

Project Cost: \$4,500

Christian Mission for the Deaf (CMD) is committed to liberating deaf people from the bondage of illiteracy, poverty, and joblessness. They have over 29 deaf churches throughout Nigeria, plus a school for deaf children. They are in need of funding to purchase materials for **120 metal double-seat school desks** for their school in Ibadan, Nigeria. (That's only \$37.50 for one desk!) The wooden ones they use now are quite old and not very sturdy for the students (see photo far right). <http://cmdeafng.com/>

## # 657 INT'L COOPERATING MINISTRIES - SOUTH AFRICA

Project Cost: \$10,000

Christians in Africa are in dire need of Bibles and discipleship materials. Many pastors in South Africa are poorly equipped to teach, and having no depth of biblical knowledge leads many to take misguided approaches to the gospel. ICM teamed up with *Judea Harvest* to give these pastors a two-week training course and instruct them to use audio-players loaded with the Mini Bible College (MBC). ICM is asking for **484 solar-powered audio players** (\$20.67 per device). <https://www.icm.org/>



## # 658 UIM INTERNATIONAL - CANADA

Project Cost: \$6,875

UIM-Canada operates a Bible camp near Houston, BC, called *Rock Nest Ranch*. It exists to bring the gospel of Christ to indigenous youth and adults through camp and training times. They have recently built a lodge that will allow the ministry to operate year-round instead of just in the summer. This project will cover the cost of **25 new bunk beds** (\$275 per bed) which can accommodate up to 50 campers. <http://www.rocknestranch.org/>



## # 659 LIVING HOPE GLOBAL MINISTRIES - HONDURAS

Project Cost: \$4,653

In addition to empowering the local church, Living Hope Global shows the love of Christ to the people of Honduras through outreach programs. They are almost done with a building project to provide housing for short-term mission teams from the States and which will also serve local pastors that attend ongoing leadership training. Living Hope is in need of a **Briggs & Stratton 20-kilowatt stand-by generator** that is able to run the entire compound when there is a power outage. <https://www.livinghopeglobalministries.org/>



## # 660 SHARE EDUCATION SERVICES - WORLDWIDE

Project Cost: \$3,948

SHARE's ministry targets the specific needs of missionary children's education. Each year SHARE serves hundreds of families, helping them understand their educational options and implementing them successfully. Education assessment through academic testing has become an important part of this process and SHARE would like to transition from using paper tests to utilizing iPads for this important task. <https://www.shareeducation.org/>

## # 661 HOPE'S PROMISE - NEPAL, VIETNAM, & ZIMBABWE

Project Cost: \$9,520

With their unique model of orphan care, Hope's Promise places children into families with indigenous Christian house parents to care for them. They partner with them to help provide for the children's physical, emotional, social, and spiritual needs. <https://www.hopespromise.com/>

**Equipment/supplies:** bedding, laptops, wardrobe closets, bookshelves, office chair, cabinet, student tables & textbooks, electric motorbike, bicycle, refrigerator, bamboo mat, air conditioner, school uniforms, and electric dryer.

## # 662 FAITH COMES BY HEARING - KAMPALA, UGANDA

Project Cost: \$5,497

FCBH's first focus was on reaching people with God's Word through audio listening devices, but as the world becomes more urban and technologically advanced, they have seized an opportunity to expand into the field of visual learning.

FCBH is taking part in a *90-Day Bible Listening Campaign* to engage people in daily Bible listening through the Audio Bible app on smartphones. They hope to form 4,000 listening groups and provide them with an opportunity to watch a gospel film in their heart language. The film combines FCBH Audio Bible recordings with LUMO videos to create a beautiful, high-quality video.




## # 663 CEF MINISTRIES - SRI LANKA

Project Cost: \$6,000

On Easter Sunday 2019, terrorist bombs in Sri Lanka attacked several churches and hotels. Among the nearly 300 dead and 500 wounded were mothers, fathers, and children. After these attacks, CEF distributed the "Do You Wonder Why?" booklets, an evangelistic tool for children who experience disasters. To launch this initiative, the booklet was translated into Tamil and Sinhala, printed, shipped, and distributed. Over 400,000 booklets have been handed out, but there is more work to be done. ## # 664 RISHAMA INT'L - NIGERIA

Project Cost: \$3,330

Rishama is an orphanage and Christian school in Nigeria where faith, learning, and socialization are cultivated. The school recently opened in September of this year and had almost twice the number of students register from what they were expecting! The staff has been buying bread and cooking meals outside in a lean-to because they lack the necessary equipment for their kitchen and dining hall. They would like to grind their own corn, mix dough, and bake their own bread. This project will provide funds for them to purchase an **oven, gas cylinder, refrigerator, deep freezer, electric mixer, grinder, cabinets, and tables.** <https://www.rishama.org/>
