



Working Among Nomads in Northern Kenya

Africa Inland Mission [Completed Project #702]



Northern Kenya is a dry, desert region effectively cut off from development and the gospel. The Africa Inland Church reaches out to marginalized people in this area, especially to the

Rendille community, a pastoral nomadic people whose identity is linked to their animals and the need to find food and water for their livestock.

Operating through Africa Inland Mission, **Tirim Christian School** offers primary and secondary education to the children of the Rendille. Many of these students do not have electricity in their homes, so attending a school with lights enables them to complete their assignments and get better grades for a better future.



Through your generosity, MPF was able to complete a project for new solar batteries and flood lights. As a result of this new solar electricity system, the school is now able to run outdoor security lights and indoor

room lights (see photos) along with improving their other electronic systems. With electricity being so unpredictable, they are grateful for another source of power!

School performance for the students has also increased now that the teachers can extend some classes into the night. The children really enjoy doing their work in the evening when it is cooler since it tends to get very hot and humid during the day.

Pastor David Gargule of Tirim Schools, wrote a thank-you note to MPF and its supporters:

*“Our prayer is that...our partners may have many opportunities to serve those who are serving... May those who give, experience the joy of giving. **Thank you for all that you are doing!**”*

Areas of Persecution Receive Access to Scripture

Faith Comes By Hearing [Past Project #701 — South Asia]

Faith Comes by Hearing (FCBH) is on a mission to record and provide God's Word in every language by the year 2033 (called *Vision 2033*).

MPF partnered with them for our Giving Tuesday Challenge in 2021 and, thanks to our many generous supporters, enough funds were raised for the purchase of **50 Gospel Film Projector Sets** to use in communities across South Asia and it is **already yielding**



results! When used alongside Audio Bible listening groups, the gospel film allows men, women, and children to see,

hear, and understand Scripture in their heart language. Each set includes an audio/video player called an **Acclaimer** (see photo) along with a speaker, screen, and case.

Every indigenous group leader receives training before organizing private viewing groups. Within the first two months of use, this film inspired people to dig deeper into Scripture and resulted in **85 new listening groups!** Praise God!

<p>720 EGYPT</p>	<p>MIDDLE EAST MEDIA has studios in North Africa and the Gulf where they are a Christian media leader in the MENA (Middle East/North Africa) region and produce a wide range of Christian media. Several years ago they launched their animation department which produces evangelistic programs for children. One of these studios has outdated and damaged equipment and will need an upgrade in order to become usable once again. They need funding to purchase a professional audio monitor speaker, two TVs, and a pre-amplifier.</p>	<p>PROJECT COST: \$4,058</p>  <p>https://www.memusa.org/</p>
<p>721 SOUTHEAST ASIA</p>	<p>INDOPARTNERS AGENCY Guide Online, the digital arm of IndoPartners, creates evangelistic articles and videos for social media in the heart languages of people groups in South Asia. So far, they have created over 1,300 articles and 350 videos! They train their native staff to disciple those who reach out to their ministry.</p> <p>Due to the sensitive nature of Christianity in this region, the ministry is entirely digital. <p>722 NIGERIA</p>	<p>CHRISTIAN MISSION FOR THE DEAF has a school for deaf boys and girls in Nigeria that is overcrowded. They are currently building on a new 39-acre site which will give them much more space. Last year our donors helped us complete a project to put a roof over the new girls' dorm; now this ministry needs to put a roof over the classrooms (see photo on right). An effective way of reaching this age group is through food services...that's why they run a café at all of their centers. Sadly, rent for their La Paz café is very high so they are hoping to purchase a food truck and take this ministry on the road! <p>725 NORTHERN KENYA</p>	<p>The Tirim Christian School operates through AFRICA INLAND MISSION and offers a Christian education to the Rendille Community, a nomadic people in Northern Kenya cut off from development and the gospel.</p> <p>They wish to start a computer lab for students and staff since most students don't have access to smart phones or computers at home. Many parents are illiterate and depend on the school for their children's educational materials, and with no internet access, teachers must hand-write each student's exams!</p> <p>Is there is a special teacher in your life? <p>726 HOME OFFICE</p>	<p>MPF first partnered with BOLD HOPE five years ago when their ministry was based in Haiti. They've since expanded into other countries, with teams in the Dominican Republic and Belize and partners in eight other areas around the world.</p> <p>To properly manage all of these teams, it's important to have the right equipment to connect with them from their headquarters in the U.S. Often the overseas teams have difficulty seeing and understanding what is being said during important meetings. SIERRA LEONE

CLC MINISTRIES INT'L makes Christian literature available to all nations. In Sierra Leone, they have three bookshops, two in the capital city of Freetown and one in a remote town called Bo. The Bo staff feel burdened to take Bibles and books into surrounding areas where many people have no means of traveling to their shop. Matthew, a CLC staff member in Bo, has a motorbike which can only carry two boxes of books at a time. MPF is raising funds to purchase and modify a **Keke tricycle** which will enable Matthew to cover a wider area around Bo and will keep dust and rain from ruining the reading materials. <https://clcusa.org/missions/>

HONDURAS

LIVING HOPE GLOBAL MINISTRIES has an opportunity to further serve the isolated Tolupan Indians who live on a remote mountain in Northwest Honduras. They currently operate Hope Children's Center where they feed, nurture, and share Christ daily with over 50 Tolupan children. The needs in this village are numerous. Mission teams who come from the U.S. to serve have nowhere to stay in the village other than the floor of the church or outdoors. There is also a great need for medical and hygiene aid for the villagers since the nearest hospital is many hours travel off the mountain!
This project will provide the village with a **Dormitory** for visiting teams and a **Community Health Center** where they can have wounds cared for and bandaged and a place for women to get proper care before and after childbirth. <https://www.livinghopeglobalministries.org/>

ROMANIA

CHILD EVANGELISM FELLOWSHIP trains local workers around the world to evangelize children, train new volunteers, and work closely with local churches. In 2022, over 250,000 Romanian children were reached with the Gospel. CEF workers also helped these children deal with the war in Ukraine. Since Ukraine borders Romania, this also gave them a unique opportunity to evangelize Ukrainian children who have taken refuge there due to the war.
Livi and Anca Dulcianu are new workers to CEF Romania who serve in an area with open doors to evangelism. They are badly in need of a newer, more reliable **ministry car** so they can continue to serve the many Good News Clubs they lead. When your Good News children actually pray for God to "take our leaders home safely," you know it's time for a new vehicle!
