Zimbabwe Orphan Ministry Now Has Transportation

A **2015 Nissan Caravan** was finally purchased by the CWO staff in Zimbabwe to help their workers serve over 300 children, 200 pastors, 30 volunteers, and eight staff members each year!

CWO Zimbabwe runs a ministry for orphans called "Our Kids" where the van is used to transport children in the program from their village homes to a weekend campsite. It has also been useful when visiting pastors need transportation from the airport to leadership conferences hosted and lead by CWO staff.

Having their own van allows the staff to go on monthly village visits to see the children

and their caregivers and address any questions or concerns. This also allows them to spend **quality time** with the children!

When the van is not being utilized for ministry use, CWO leadership hires out the van to local schools, helping generate funds which are used to support even more children in the Our Kids Program!

The **ONeWAY MINISTRIES** team in Ghana, West Africa, travels the country to share the gospel to unreached people groups, many of whom live in very remote areas. These journeys can take them up to 300 miles away from their main office on roads that are unpaved and prone to flooding and potholes. Their current truck frequently breaks down and is no longer reliable enough to use in more remote regions. A **new pick-up truck** would be a blessing for this hard-working team! **Please join us in getting a truck for this ministry!**

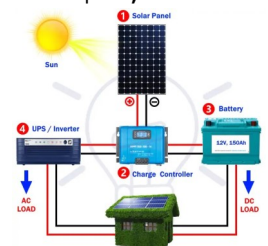

UGANDA

REACHING AFRICA'S UNREACHED (RAU) trains pastors and leaders at their 26-acre site, which is less than a mile from the South Sudan border. Their Ministry House accommodates missionaries and teams of teachers and medical personnel. RAU recently added a living area at the house for a new family, but the current solar-power system is not adequate for their growing needs and they are "limping along" with this old system. Please join us in raising funds for a **solar power upgrade** for their Ministry House so they can continue teaching and serving the church in Uganda!

SOUTH ASIA

INDOPARTNERS AGENCY ministers in an area that is frequently hostile to Christianity. Through a digital evangelism system called **Guide Online**, they create articles and videos and post them on websites, FaceBook, and other social media outlets. They have 30 national staff responsible for content creation, promotion, and communication with interested contacts. The ministry needs **two new laptops** for their Guide Online staff so they can continue to share the gospel with millions of people each year!

742 **THE FRIENDS OF ISRAEL GOSPEL MINISTRY (FOI)** is a worldwide evangelical ministry proclaiming biblical truth and bringing physical and spiritual comfort to the Jewish people. FOI recently built an audio/visual studio in the U.S. in which they hope to increase production of biblical teaching on prophecy as it relates to Israel. These resources will be distributed through social media to churches, support groups, and individuals throughout the U.S. and around the world. MPF is raising funds for Aputure lighting equipment which is necessary to enhance production quality.

743 **GOSPELINK** supports national ministry leaders around the world. Their partner in Zambia, **Ambassador International University (AIU)**, makes it possible for students to earn a four-year accredited residential degree program. On the AIU campus, students are also taught how to support their families while on the mission field by raising over 1,000 chickens, which also earns needed funds and supplements their daily meals. AIU would like to make their own feed pellets and employ local farmers to grow the crops. To begin this, they will need a feed pellet machine, feed mixer, and electrical materials. It's a great way for the school to keep costs down, help local farmers, and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ to their neighbors!

744 **PAK7** reaches Pakistani Christians (roughly 2 percent of the population) by making high-quality, theological videos shown on satellite TV and social media, with nearly 70 million views on their social media posts alone—75 percent coming from inside Pakistan and 25 percent from surrounding countries. With emphasis on discipleship, PAK7 trains young Pakistani men and women for nine weeks at their Media School, later engaging them for a 12-month internship. MPF is raising funds for media equipment which will assist them in taking in action shots and editing programs for their 24-hour satellite TV channel.

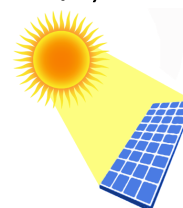

They operate programs in four countries where they place orphaned or vulnerable children with Christian caregivers if no biological relatives are available. Each Hope's Promise Home has various needs for the children such as education and everyday living. Since Covid and the war in Ukraine, economic hardships in Kenya have deeply impacted the availability of power and increased the costs of electricity. Please help us in raising funds for solar panels to be installed at a Hope's Promise Home where four caregivers look after 23 school-age children.

Their partner, Pastor Enosh, works with more than 300 village pastors and cares for over 100 children through *Truthful Gospel Ministries*. MPF is raising funds for sewing machines which will be given to women after completing a sewing training course, providing an income for their families; also for motorcycles to be given to poor village pastors.

747 **EXPATRIATE EDUCATION INTERNATIONAL** is the owner and supporter of *International Academy Saint Petersburg*, a K-12 Christian educational institution. Students who attend the academy come from a variety of backgrounds and nations. More than 50 percent of them are hearing the gospel and receiving Bible lessons for the first time!

748 DOMINICAN REPUBLIC	<p>ACTS BEYOND supports and directs the <i>Santiago Theological Seminary</i> in the Dominican Republic, a ministry which provides excellent biblical and theological education to Latin America and beyond. Once students graduate, they will be instrumental in evangelism, church planting, and cross-cultural mission work. 749 FRANCE	<p>In 2021, FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL MISSION (FIM) sent missionaries to start a French-speaking church in Saint-Lo, Normandy, a city with a diverse population of French citizens, immigrants, and refugees. They began with a small group of believers and now have over 40 people attending, half who are French citizens. Their vision is to “Liberate Normandy Again” with the truth and love of Jesus Christ!</p> <p>There is great need in the region to help people going through hardships. The church currently utilizes four rooms to house and feed immigrants, refugees, and homeless French people, but they could use several <u>household and office items</u> to better equip this vital outreach. Items needed are bunk beds, double and single beds, pillows, wardrobes, oven, iPad, projector, printer, and a dehumidifier.</p>	<p>PROJECT COST: \$4,450</p> 
750 SOUTH SUDAN	<p>The MAMA PROJECT got its start by doing nutrition work with severely malnourished children in Honduras. They have since expanded to support vulnerable communities in Haiti, India, Tanzania, Kenya, and their latest partnership in the South Sudan where they work with refugees in Internally Displaced Peoples (IDP) camps. Individuals in these camps lack food, clean water, medical care, and all the basics of life.</p> <p>While MAMA Project’s focus is on water, deworming, and malnutrition, they also work to improve the care of pregnant mothers by putting together “Safe Mother and Baby Toolkits”. These kits provide resources and training which introduce life-saving technologies to health care workers. They need funding for a <u>handheld ultrasound machine</u> to complete a kit which will go to one of these IDP Camps.</p>	<p>PROJECT COST: \$4,935</p>
